On enrolment, you will be allocated a specific trainer who will act in the role of leadership mentor to guide and support you, along with other participants, throughout the program. Together you will form your own leadership group and become members of an online learning community. The role of the trainer/mentor is to facilitate group discussion through online chats and forum discussions, and to step you through the program as you work your way through set tasks, set yourself goals and reflect in your journal.

The training materials provided on the commencement of this program will form the basis of your learning and leadership skill development. A reflective journal and leadership survey will be used extensively, as will our chat room and discussion forum - our online communication tools.

Although this program requires considerable reading, as well as active participation in networking and online discussion, it also relies heavily on reflection, self evaluation and personal goal setting.

All program materials, including the reflective journal, are provided for you online. All you need is access to a computer and the internet.

This promises to be an interesting journey, with measurable outcomes and a clear benefit to individuals who wish to improve their own work performance and workplace outcomes.
